Buzz, buzz, buzz.....do you hear all the busy little bees at work. It's all the club members working with Jan and JB on the upcoming "Fast Cars In The Fort" Corvette Show. Things are really coming together with the help of many club members all pulling together to make this a great show. Now all we need is for Corvette owners, including our own club members, to register their cars and for Mother Nature to give us a good weather weekend. We have volunteers to cover all the events we want to do, but it would make it easier on them if we had a few more hands helping out. There is still time for anybody who wants to lend a helping hand to jump right in and get to work. Friday morning registration and Poker Run/Amazing Race events are all set, but we will not know how many will be participating until that morning so any additional helpers would be wonderful. That does not mean that you cannot participate yourself though. Once we get everybody registered and sent off, all of our club members are welcome to join in on the events of the day. There will be some nice prizes for the winners of the Poker Run and the Amazing Race (It could even be the same person, hhhhhMmmmm) and we want everyone to be able to participate. It would be a big help if when you pre-register your car you could let us know if you will be participating in either the Poker Run or the Amazing Race/Poker Run.

Let me tell you a little about each event. The Poker Run has a set scenic route that you will know before you leave and all you have to do is go to each stop on the map and pick up an envelope with a playing card inside. You can go at your own pace, stop and enjoy the scenery, eat, shop, or whatever, anywhere along the route, but you must be back at the pavilion by 4:00 p.m. to turn in your cards. The Amazing Race has all the same stops as the Poker Run, but you get to decide the best route to get you to all these stops in the least amount of time and the least miles traveled. If you register for the Amazing Race you are automatically entered into the Poker Run. So if you're fast, know all the short cuts, and have a good poker hand, you could go home with both prizes. The route is about 100 miles and should take about 2 Hrs and 20 Min. to complete. However if you are an Amazing Race participant, I expect you will find a shorter route and complete it in a lot shorter time period (unless you get lost). So I hope you will decide to do at least one of these events.

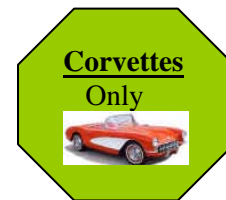

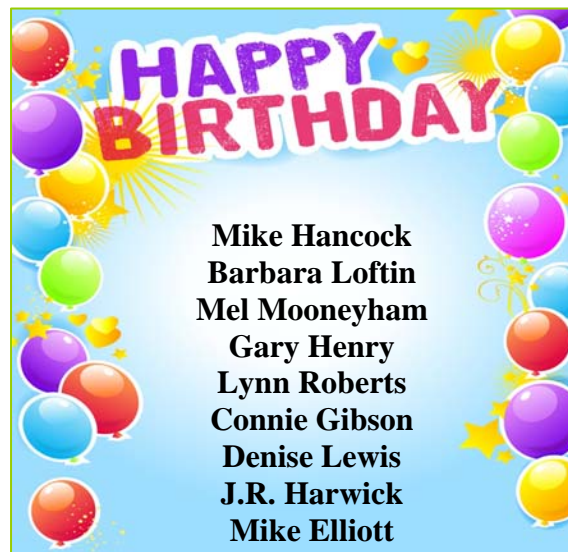
